



College Credit Options:

Students interested in earning college credit, while enrolled at Kalon, will meet with the Academic Advisor, Director and parents to determine the best pathway for the individual. Students enrolled in either OCHS or PSEO programs are responsible for meeting all high school graduation requirements. Eligibility requirements may vary depending upon the college and student grade level. We suggest this for juniors & seniors only, starting with 1 course. Any courses taken become part of the student’s permanent college transcript.

Kalon Prep Academy students can earn dual-credit while participating in the online college courses while remaining in our high school setting.
